To help students accelerate their learning, United Way is partnering with Hamilton County Schools and various after-school community sites to offer high-impact, low-ratio tutoring.

The United Way of Greater Chattanooga Tutoring Program is actively **recruiting paid tutors** to provide low-ratio instruction and personalized support to **TN public school students in 1st - 8th grade**.

Tutors will receive virtual training and support on curriculum, the technology platform, Go Schoolbox, and how to create an engaging learning session. Tutoring sessions will **begin the week of 1/9/2023**.

Tutors will be compensated based on their credentials.

Certified and Retired Teachers: \$30/hour, additional 30 minutes of paid planning time per week

Community Members + College Students + Paraprofessionals: \$20/hour, additional 30 minutes of paid planning time per week

HOW IT WORKS

Tutors will be matched based on availability, to **provide support in three, thirty-minute-long tutoring sessions per week for 10-12 weeks**.

Our goal is for each student to receive a total of 30 tutoring sessions per semester with the same volunteer. Sessions will begin the week of January 9, 2023.
