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

CHATTANOOGA AREA FOOD BANK

Mission: Founded in 1972, the mission of the Chattanooga Area Food Bank (CAFB) is to lead a network of partners in eliminating hunger and promoting better nutrition in our region.

Funding Focus: On-board new schools in Walker and Catoosa County and provide them with the necessary equipment and supplies to rescue uneaten, packaged food and fruit from school meals and repurpose it to feed students and their families over weekends and school breaks. **(Catalyst)**
