SUPPORT HAMILTON COUNTY STUDENTS TODAY

To help students accelerate their learning, United Way is partnering with Hamilton County Schools and various after-school community sites to offer high-impact, low-ratio tutoring.

The United Way of Greater Chattanooga Tutoring Program is actively **recruiting paid tutors** for *literacy* to provide low-ratio instruction and personalized support to **TN public school students in 1st - 8th grade**.

Tutors will receive all necessary training on the curriculum and will become familiar with GoSchoolBox, while also learning creative and engaging ways to connect and build relationships with the students. Tutoring sessions will begin the week of **January 22** and run through **April 25, 2024**.

Tutors will be compensated based on their credentials.

Certified and Retired Teachers: \$30/hour, additional hour of paid planning time per week

Community Members + College Students + Paraprofessionals: \$20/hour, additional hour of paid planning time per week

HOW IT WORKS

Tutors will be matched based on availability, to **provide support in three, thirty-minute-long tutoring sessions per week for 10-12 weeks**. Our goal is for each student to receive a total of 720 minutes of tutoring with the same tutor. Tutoring sessions will begin the week of January 22 and run through April 25, 2024.
